

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2014-01**

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING CHARGES FOR LIFE SUPPORT EMERGENCY  
AMBULANCE SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE BRISTOL KENDALL FIRE  
PROTECTION DISTRICT, KENDALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS AND REPEALING  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2003-01 OF THE BRISTOL KENDALL FIRE PROTECTION  
DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District, Kendall County, Illinois (the "District") has previously adopted Ordinance Number 2003-01 entitled "An Ordinance fixing charges for life support emergency ambulance service provided by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District, Kendall County, Illinois"; and

**WHEREAS**, upon the recommendation of the District Fire Chief, the Board should establish current reasonable costs for providing life support ambulance service; and

**WHEREAS**, the District provides, or causes to be provided, an emergency ambulance service within and to points outside the District; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 22 of the "Fire Protection District Act" "70 ILCS 707/22" authorizes the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the District to "fix, charge and collect fees for emergency ambulance service within or outside of the fire protection district not exceeding the reasonable cost of the service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that District residents pay taxes which contribute to the District's operation of emergency medical service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that many non-residents of the District request and are provided emergency ambulance service when they are within the jurisdiction of the District without contributing to the expense of providing such service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District that residents who are provided emergency ambulance service when they are within the jurisdiction of the District be charged for the emergency ambulance service provided; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that it is reasonable and proper to charge residents of the District and non-residents of the District for emergency ambulance service provided to them; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the reasonable cost of providing basic life support emergency ambulance service to the residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$450.00 per call and the reasonable cost of providing advanced life support (ALS1) emergency medical service to residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$550.00 per call, and the reasonable cost of providing advanced life support (ALS2) emergency medical service to residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$650.00 per call, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and the reasonable cost of providing medical treatment without the need for transport to a medical facility to residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$100.00 per call plus the cost of supplies used, and such other reasonable charges for additional available services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the reasonable cost of providing basic life support emergency ambulance service to the non-residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$650.00 per call and the reasonable cost of providing advanced life support (ALS1) emergency medical service to non-residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$750.00 per call, and the reasonable cost of providing advanced life support (ALS2) emergency medical service to non-residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$850.00 per call, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and the reasonable cost of providing medical treatment without the need for transport to a medical facility to non-residents of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is \$100.00 per call plus the cost of supplies used, and such other reasonable charges for additional available services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District, Kendall County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The preambles of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby incorporated in the text hereof as if set out herein in full.

**SECTION 2:** Each person receiving basic life support emergency ambulance service who is a resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$450.00 per

call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 3:** Each person receiving advanced life support (ALS1) emergency ambulance service who is a resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$550.00 per call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 4:** Each person receiving advanced life support (ALS2) emergency ambulance service who is a resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$650.00 per call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 5:** Each person receiving medical treatment without the need for transport to a medical facility who is a resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$100.00 per call for said service, and the cost for any supplies used, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 6:** Each person receiving basic life support emergency ambulance service who is a non-resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$650.00 per call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 7:** Each person receiving advanced life support (ALS1) emergency ambulance service who is a non-resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay

the sum of \$750.00 per call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 8:** Each person receiving advanced life support (ALS2) emergency ambulance service who is a non-resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$850.00 per call for said service, and an additional \$10.00 per transport mile, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 9:** Each person receiving medical treatment without the need for transport to a medical facility who is a non-resident of the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District shall pay the sum of \$100.00 per call for said service, and the cost for any supplies used, and such other reasonable charges for additional services, as may be from time to time approved by the Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees, within thirty days of being billed thereof.

**SECTION 10:** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 11:** All Ordinances specifically including Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Ordinance Number 2003-01, resolutions or other proceedings in conflict herewith, be and are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION 12:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of May 1, 2014, after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.




