

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Sealcoating, Crack Filling, and Re-Striping

Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is accepting proposals for blacktop sealcoating and parking lot striping. The Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District must maintain operations 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **Awarded contractor must comply with all parts of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 et seq., including but not limited to, all wage requirements and notice and record keeping duties.**

Submittal:

Proposals are to be submitted to Chief Michael Hitzemann at Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District, 103 East Beaver Street Yorkville, Illinois 60560 by 11:00 am on July 6, 2016 to be eligible for consideration. All proposals shall be sealed and shall be valid for at least 60 days. Any questions shall be handled before proposals are submitted. Proposal:

Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District is requesting proposals for sealcoating the parking lot area at Bristol Kendall Fire Station 2 located at 2101 McHugh Road in Yorkville, Illinois. The parking lot area is approximately 11,455 square feet.

Scope of work:

- A. Preparation prior to sealcoating the entire area will be swept and cleaned with commercial blowers. Oil spots will be cleaned and primary as necessary.
- B. Crack filling – machine clean cracks, removing all weeds and debris and seal with hot, applied crack sealant.
- C. Striping –replacing all 4" parking striping and ADA paint markings to meet code requirements

Insurance:

Contractor shall be fully insured for the duration of the project with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000. Contractor shall provide a copy of valid insurance with their proposal. Contractor is responsible for carrying all required insurance and bonds along with general workman's compensation insurance. Upon acceptance of a proposal, Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District will require a Certificate of Insurance be provided with Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District named as an additional insured.

Acceptance of proposal:

Proposals will be reviewed and awarded by July 15, 2016. The Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject and bid, or portion thereof, or to waive minor deviations from the proposals, if it deems it is in the public interest to do so.
